We have a couple of staffing changes for this term. Mrs Mckillop has been replaced by Mrs Bigge in year 12 and 13 photography. One group who need to be mentioned are the students who travelled to Te Awamutu in the last week of term one to trial for the Central North Island Area Schools Teams in a range of sports. From our trialists, Zhane Taikato, Emmitt Wickens, and Kalani Cooney named in the tournament team for basketball with Reuben Holmes as a non travelling reserve. Lena Heegardt, Jacqueline Hay, Qiana Wharepapa, and Mia Brown were all selected for Volleyball, Lena and Qiana in Rugby 7's, and Mia for Netball. Congratulations to all these students who now progress to the national Area Schools trials in Whangarei during the next school holidays. Good luck to all students who are participating in winter sports. I look forward to watching as many of you as possible in action over the coming weeks.

A reminder to our senior students about the importance of correct uniform. 

**R**ain waters trees and knocks them down



**EMAILED NEWSLETTERS:** Newsletters will be emailed to all parents/caregivers who have a current email address registered with the school. There will be a few hard copies available at the school office if receiving an email is not suitable.
